

## 7 Steps to Sewing Success



### First Class Supply List

#### Simplicity Pattern 2332

This is a multi-size pattern for boys and girls sizes 4 - 16. (Chest sizes range from 23" - 34")

#### Fabric

- Determine which size is appropriate for the child. Do this by comparing the child's body measurements (chest and hips) to the body measurements on the back of the pattern envelope.
- Printed cotton fabric or printed cotton flannel is a good choice.
- Purchase the amount of fabric based on the size and purchase enough for both top and pants.

#### Do not purchase:

- Knit fabric.
- Checked, striped or plaid fabric.
- Fabric with a black or dark blue background.

## Where to Shop for Fabric

*No matter where you shop, take your pattern and this list with you and please ask the store staff for help in selecting your fabric.*

### Quilt Fabric Shops

Quilt shops offer a great selection of cotton fabric. In Lewisville, you will find a wide selection of fabric at Quilt Country at the northwest corner of I-35 and Fox Avenue.

### Chain Fabric Stores

Joann Fabrics in Denton has a selection of cotton fabric & flannel appropriate for pajamas. But the Lewisville Joann Fabrics has a much wider selection. You might also try Hobby Lobby.

*Keep your receipts. You can return fabric to Joann Fabrics if you have not washed it or cut into it. I don't know about quilt shops. Ask.*

For the 1<sup>st</sup> class you will need the following items:

- Fabric
- Pattern
- Red ball point or felt tip pen (purchase at an office supply store)
- Black Ultra Fine Tip Sharpie Permanent Marker (purchase at an office supply store)
- Pocket Folder (purchase at an office supply store)
- Removable Scotch Tape (purchase at an office supply store)
- Your sewing machine, foot control, power cord and instruction manual.



Be prepared to purchase sewing notions and tools at each class.
