

Appliqué Tulip Towel

Class Supply List

Two Towels

I have ordered towels in an off white. Please do not bring any other towels for this project. Towels are \$4.75 each payable to the instructor.

Cotton Quilting Fabric for Two Towels

- For Tulips: Three coordinating fabrics. Cut two 4" squares from each fabric.
- For Short Leaf: Cut two rectangles 3" x 4".
- For Large Stalks and Leaves: Cut four rectangles 5" x 8".
- For Planter: Cut two rectangles 5" x 8".



Sewing Machine and Feet

- Sewing machine, power cord and accessory case.
- Open toe appliqué foot
- Optional: Extension table for machine
- Empty bobbin

Notions

- Sharp 5" scissors
- Seam ripper
- Pencil with good eraser
- Package of 8" x 10" Steam a Seam 2
- Package of Sulky Totally Stable
- Package of Sulky Sheer Cutaway Extra (you will need this before class)
- Appliqué Pressing Sheet
- A few straight pins
- Optional, but very helpful: a portable pressing surface such as Quilter's Cut n Press II or Cushioned Quilter's Square.



Needles & Thread

- The needle and thread used for appliqué depends upon the appliqué stitches available on your sewing machine.
- If you own a 80/12 denim and/or a 80/12 top stitch needle, bring them to class.
- Discussion on possible needles and threads will be part of the class.

To Do Before Class

- Cut pieces of fabric to size (listed above).
- Cut Sulky Soft n Sheer Cutaway Extra stabilizer to the same sizes as the fabric pieces.
- Fuse stabilizer to the wrong side of each fabric piece. (Follow instructions included with the stabilizer.)
